


# Questions from Ofsted for governors on the quality of education

The 2019 inspection framework includes a new 'quality of education' judgement. This means inspectors will likely ask you about the intent, implementation and impact of your curriculum.

How to use these questions: Get your board together, discuss how you might respond to questions like these if Ofsted call, and do a few practice runs. You'll prepare for any interviews that do happen and also spot gaps in knowledge to address through other governor development activities.

Think about how what you teach is shaped by things like your school context, ethos and vision, improvement priorities, committees and local community


# Curriculum implementation

- How do you know that teachers have the subject knowledge required to deliver the curriculum well?
- How do you evaluate whether the curriculum in your school is broad and balanced?

### Preparation tips

- Monitoring of performance management and CPD updates help you know that teachers have the knowledge they need
- You'll know lots about what's going on in the classroom from your curriculum policy, governor visits and headteachers reports

## Curriculum impact



How do you monitor achievement and progress for pupils in receipt of the pupil premium? Is your school effectively closing the gap?

#### Preparation tips

- Dig in to your minutes to remind yourself of the data you look at, and the questions you ask to interrogate it during meetings
- Your pupil premium strategy and impact reports should be telling you how this funding is being used



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
